

Emergency Medical Services – Emergency Medical Technician

2009-2010

Program Overview

This 120-hour (six semester credit) EMS 1020 course is approved by the State of Minnesota EMSRB (Emergency Medical Services Regulatory Board). Upon completion of the course, the student will be eligible to take the National Registry of EMT-Basic Examinations offered at Century College. By successfully passing the EMT Registry tests, the student will gain certification from the State of Minnesota and the National Registry of EMT.

A 10-hour clinical observation will be scheduled outside of class time to observe in an emergency department. During the clinical, the student will be able to participate by using some of the skills learned in the course such as: vital signs, oxygen administration and airway management, CPR skills, patient assessment, lifting and moving, assisting ED staff with patient care, etc.

The EMT course is presented in a traditional format. Instruction will include lecture, hands-on demonstration, and practice of all mandatory skills. A final written and practical exam will be given after each module and at course completion.

EMT courses are located on the East Campus of Century College. A clinical fee of \$9.75 is required at the time of registration. Testing fees totaling \$75.00 will be collected near the end of the course for the National Registry of EMT Practical Test. \$70.00 will be collected by an outside agency for the National Registry Written Exam.

Required textbooks are available in the Century College bookstore located on the West Campus.

Course Prerequisite

A current American Heart Association Healthcare Provider CPR card is required. Students that would like to enter the EMT course but need the CPR certification, may contact the EMT Coordinator to make arrangements to fulfill this requirement.
