2.1.0.1 Student Stipends

Stipend Recipients: Student senate presidents and other student leaders as determined by the campus selection process.

Stipend Form: Stipends shall be awarded as paid credits

Stipend Size and Frequency: The College shall award fourteen credits per term, for a total of twenty-eight credits for the academic year. These credits shall be awarded to students for a quarter/semester as follows:

1. Eight credits shall be awarded to the student senate president.
2. Six credits shall be awarded to student leaders; the awarding of these six credits shall be determined by a committee comprised mainly of students. These credits can be awarded in any denomination--three two-credit awards, two three-credit awards, one six-credit award, etc.
3. The Student Life Director will ask for nominations from club/organization members, advisors, faculty and staff.

Method of Financing Stipend Awards: Stipends shall be financed by the college through a procedure of tuition reimbursements. The stipends will be funded by the College through the Student Life budget (student activity fees).

Process for Administering Stipend Awards:

1. The College shall reimburse the student for the stipend credits at the completion of each term.
2. Stipend recipients must obtain a C grade or better for each credit of reimbursement.
3. Stipends shall be awarded for the academic terms (does not include summer term).
4. Unused credits from one term may be added to another term's stipend; however, credits may not be carried over from year to year.
5. None of the sixteen credits intended for the student senate president may be awarded to any other individual.
6. Exceptions may be petitioned to the Vice President of Student Services
