3.17.0.2 Awarding Credit

Registered students who are able to demonstrate achievement in the content of college-level courses or who have successfully completed appropriate non-collegiate educational experiences may be eligible to receive credit at Century College. Requirements may be fulfilled in two ways:

1. The awarding of college credit towards a degree.
2. The waiving of pre-requisites or requirements without awarding credit.

Students may earn credit through the following:

- CLEP
- Certified Professional Secretary (CPS) Exam
- Credit by Discipline Exam
- Credit or Waiver for Armed Services Training
- USAFI Courses
- Minnesota Vocational-Technical Colleges
- Private Vocational Schools
- Work Experience/Competency Based Education
- Organized Educational Experience
- Advanced Placement Program of the College Board
- Independent Study
- Internships
- Credit for Activities
