### **6.24.0.1 - Smoking/Chewing Tobacco Policy**

Century College is a member of the Minnesota State College and University System. As a member, Century College will comply with the Minnesota Clean Indoor Air Act. This will include all buildings and facilities.

There will be designated areas on campus where smoking will be permitted. Smoking will be limited to these designated areas. The use of smokeless tobacco is prohibited in all building and on the grounds of Century College.

#### **Designated Smoking Areas include:**

East Campus:

- \* parking lot area
- \* smoking hut located north side of building, near the Bruening Room entrance

West Campus:

- \* parking lot area
- \* smoking hut located outside the cafeteria on the south side of the building

Century College is committed to providing a clean air environment. Other than the designated areas identified above, smoking will not be allowed. This will include all building entrances or exits. Signs will be posted to identify locations of the smoking areas.

#### **Enforcement:**

The Public Safety unit will be the primary responsible college personnel to enforce this college policy. Other administrative unit employees may also provide enforcement. Students, employees or community members who violate this policy may be fined \$25. Students and employees may also face other disciplinary actions as defined by college policy or employee contracts.
